Guidelines of SS Multidisciplinary Research Journal

Guidelines to the Contributors/Authors

1. All submitted articles: (a) Should be original and unpublished research (experimental or theoretical) results; (b) Should not be under consideration for publication elsewhere, (c) Should contain research questions and contents that are detailed, new, and relevant to the Journal readers/researchers; (d) Should be in **English** for the publication in the Journal.
2. Soft copies of the articles should be submitted in both PDF formats and MS Word (preferably MS Word 7/10/13) using **12-font size Times New Roman for English, and 14-font size Preeti for Nepali**.
3. Articles should include a cover page that bears the author's short introduction, the title of the article, an abstract, and keywords. The author's name should not appear in any part of the article.
4. The article should be between 3000 to 5000 words, including abstract, illustrations, graphs, tables, and charts; must be double-spaced throughout.
5. The article should follow the APA format/guidelines.

6. General Checklist of article contents (Based on University Grant Commission, Nepal)
 - a) Title of the article
 - b) Abstract
 - c) Key Words: Not more than five to seven
 - d) Introduction /background
 - e) Methodology
 - f) Results and Discussion: justification of interpretations and conclusions
 - g) Conclusion: importance, validity, and generality of conclusions
 - h) References/Works Cited, tables, and figures: APA
7. The author will solely be held accountable for their views and, therefore, the articles published in the journal do not reflect the views or policies of either **College or the Editorial Board**.
8. The journal follows a blind submission policy and articles will anonymously be reviewed by peers.
9. Once all submissions are received and reviewed, the reviewers will recommend selected articles/manuscripts with their suggestions to the editorial board for publication. Then the articles will be sent back to the writers along with reviewers' suggestions. Rejected articles will be returned to the writers on time.

10. The editorial board will have the right to make the final decision on publication.
